Special Voters' Assembly Meeting
Wednesday, April 12, 2017

A special Voters' Assembly meeting convened Wednesday, April 12, 2017, at 7:03 p.m. with the sole item of business to extend a call for a full-time eighth grade teacher to Emmanuel-Faith Lutheran School. The meeting was called to order by President David Sjuts with opening prayer by Pastor Mike Neidow. Roll call was taken by signing in at the door; quorum was met.

A request for previously-approved members to the Assembly to sign the Constitution was made with no new members present to sign. No nominations for new voters were made.

Emmanuel-Faith School Board chairman, Ryan Koch, presented Laura Smith as the Board's recommendation to whom to extend a call for the position of full-time teacher for the eighth grade. Mr. Koch shared that the candidate has obtained her Bachelors' Degree in Education and Mathematics with a Lutheran teaching certificate in 2013 from Concordia University in Seward, Nebraska. Koch also shared that Mrs. Smith is a native of Pleasant Dale, Nebraska, and currently resides in York with membership at Faith Lutheran Church. Mrs. Smith has served as a substitute teacher at various schools in the area, but has not been called at a Lutheran school, so will need to be reinstated as a candidate for call by the LCMS Nebraska District. Motion to extend a call to Laura Smith was made by Chairman Koch; motion seconded by Garold Leggott. Unanimous vote of the assembly was made in favor of extending the call to Mrs. Smith; motion carried.


